### *What does my child need for the first day of Summer Camp?*

We ask that each child bring a full change of clothes to keep at Summer Camp in case of accidents and sun screen. For the pool, children need to bring their swimsuit, towel, and sandals.

### *Lunch was provided in previous years. Why is it not being provided this year?*

Due to new Health Department regulations we cannot provide lunch at Summer Camp. We are planning on pizza Fridays to be catered by an area restaurant. Tuition has been discounted due to this change.

### *What is the Capital Assessment Fee?*

We charge all families a Capital Assessment Fee. Our buildings and equipment take a daily pounding from the activities of the children. In order to prepare for the additional wear and tear we are proactive and charge \$25 for each child in anticipation of maintenance and repairs. We have already freshly painted the majority of the building's interior.
